PURPOSE

The Martha Adams Chapter of Grambling University National Alumni Association awards a scholarship to college bound high school seniors and current college students based on demonstrated academic achievement and financial need.

CRITERIA

To be eligible for assistance, the student must be a graduating high school senior or a current college student who resides in St. Helena, St. Tammany or Tangipahoa Parish and **who intends to enroll in Grambling State University**.

REQUIREMENTS

- 1. High school seniors must be a graduate of a public or private high school located in St. Helena, St. Tammany, or Tangipahoa Parish. College students must have a permanent home address in one of the above parishes.
- 2. Applicants must have a cumulative Grade Point Average of at least **2.5** to qualify for the award. A transcript must be submitted indicating the **final GPA for high school seniors** or the **current GPA for college** applicants.
- 3. Applicants are required to submit an original 500 word typed essay.
- 4. A signed Scholarship Funds Disbursement Disclaimer must be submitted. A Parent/Guardian signature is required for applicants under 18.

AMOUNT

The scholarship will be in the amount of a one-time award of \$500.00.

DEADLINE

The application deadline is **Friday**, **May 5**, **2023**. All applications must be mailed to and deposited in the chapter mailbox or emailed by the deadline. All applications received after the **May 5th** deadline will not be considered. <u>Award notification date</u>: <u>May 12</u>, <u>2023</u>. - double-spaced,
- 12-point Arial font,
- one-inch margin on all sides, and
- applicant's full name typed in the upper right-hand corner of each page.
- A cover sheet is required.

ESSAY QUESTION

In the past few years, there has been a heightened awareness of social justice issues in this country relating to incidents involving people of color. Sparked by the high profile killings of George Floyd, Breonna Taylor, and most recently Tyre Nichols, activists along with movements such as Black Lives Matter and Say Their Names have called for an end to systemic racism and racial injustice. In what ways can college students help end racial inequality in America?

The essay is an important part of the selection process. In reviewing the essays, the committee will consider the following criteria in scoring the essays:

- Creativity
- Correct grammar and punctuation
- Originality and quality of ideas presented
- Use of research materials to support ideas and assumptions
- Adherence to essay guidelines
